This indenture made the 16th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and ninety-two between Mrs Johnson Sheriff of Santa Rosa County, State of Florida of the first part and Joseph Ollinger of the second part. Whereas by virtue of certain Execution issued out of said Circuit Court for Santa Rosa County aforesaid, wherein Black Preston et al, Rouse Hemphre et al, Horbisoid, Gathright, Stauffer Esq, Leman et al, H. G. Fisher, B. J. Wolf, Bonds, C. Loggins et al, Moses Lieb, Son, Potter Parlin et al, J. Gimmerson et al and James McDonnell were plain tiffs and Geo. A. Curry was defendant directed and delivered to the said Sheriff, commanding him that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements of said defendant, he cause to be made certain moneys in said Execution specified, the said Sheriff did buy on and sign all the estate, right, title and interest which the said defendant had, of in and to the property herein after described, and on the first Monday in July A.D. 1892, being the 4th day of the month and a legal sale day, sold the said property at public auction in front of the Court house in the town of Milton, in said State and County, having first given public notice of the time and place of such sale by advertising said property for sale, in manner and form as required by the Statute in such case, made and provided, in the "Milton Clarion" a newspaper published in said Town of Milton in said County, for thirty days next preceding said day of sale, and that at such sale the said property was struck off to the said party of the second part for the sum of thirty Dollars. The being the highest bidde therefor and then being the highest sum bid for the same.

Now this instrument witnesseth that the said party of the first part as Sheriff as aforesaid, by virtue of the said Execution and in pursuance of the Statute in such case made and provided and in consideration of the sum of money so bid as aforesaid, and in had paid to the said party of the first part by the said party of the second part at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is truly acknowledged, both granted bargained sold and conveyed all by their presents doth grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Joseph Ollinger, the said party of the second part all the estate right title and interest which the said defendant had on the 2nd day of May A.D. 1892 or at any time after wards of in and to all that certain piece or parcel of land lying and being situate in the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida and within the Corporate limits of the Town of Milton and known and described as follows to wit: Lot 3 Block 1653 and Lot 6 to Lot 6 91 in sec 7 P.
