

Contract  
 J. H. Hinck  
 to  
 Parodi & Co

This agreement made and entered into this the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of August 1892 by and between those of Hinck of Waller County Fla and Parodi & Co of Davis Ross Co Fla. Witnesseth that said J. H. Hinck agree to furnish to said Parodi & Co and deliver to the boom at the mouth of Yellow River by April 1893 or before from three thousand to four thousand Saw Logs (Pine Saw Logs) and Parodi & Co agree to receive them and pay for them (all advances deducted) at the following scale of prices - for 15 ft or less average 6<sup>cts</sup> per ft; It is further more agreed that Parodi & Co shall advance 50<sup>cts</sup> per log in order to enable him to carry out this contract. All advances to bear 10 per cent interest. Parodi & Co will send an agent semi monthly to count and brand said logs and on report of said agent the advances will be made to said Hinck in accordance of number of logs. for which advances said Parodi & Co shall take him upon all said logs, and said Parodi & Co are hereby authorized in case of any accident to said Hinck; or whenever they may deem it necessary for their security to take possession of said logs and get them to market at the expense of said Hinck.

It is also agreed that said Hinck shall drive or have said logs driven to the boom, at the mouth of Yellow River as fast as water will admit and deliver them for inspection to such inspection as said Hinck shall select. If said Hinck select Parodi & Co's Inspector the inspection charges are at Parodi & Co's expense, if he select other Inspector said Inspector charges at at said Hinck's expense. Said logs not to be deemed delivered until the same have been inspected and delivered to said Parodi & Co or their agent to receive them, and when so made, final payment of same logs will be made to said Hinck.

It is further more agreed and understood that all logs irrespective of length or cubic measurement not measuring 12 in diameter shall not be deemed bargained or sold at the price above mentioned but shall be set a part, the price to be paid for them subject to such agreement as said Hinck and said Parodi & Co shall agree upon.

And said Hinck Covenant that said logs are taken from land to which he has good right to take the same and that the same are unincumbered, and that he will defend said Parodi & Co against any and all claims of the United States Government, the Atlantic R Road or other parties whatsoever.
