County of Escambia } that for and in consideration of the
sum of One (\$1.00) dollar paid and
deemed to be paid by the Trustees of the Billogny
Baptist Church to the Louisville & Nashville Railroad
Company, a corporation chartered by the State of Kentucky,
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said
Louisville & Nashville Railroad Company has granted
bargained and sold and by their forecloses does
grant bargain sell and convey unto said
Trustees of the Billogny Baptist Church all the
following tract or parcels of land, situated in
the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida, and
described as follows to-wit: Commencing at
the South West Corner of the lot numbered five (5)
of Section five (5) in Township two (2) South of
Range Twenty six (26) west - running thence
north along the dividing line between Section
five (5) and six (6) nine (9) chains, thence East five
(5) chains thence South nine (9) chains thence west to
point of commencement. Containing Four 7/10 acres
more or less - To have and to hold unto the
said Trustees of the Billogny Baptist Church their
successors and assigns forever.

Now therefore in consideration of the premises, the
said Louisville & Nashville Railroad Company hereby
warrants and defends the title in and to the
aforesaid premises to the said Billogny Baptist
Church in fee simple forever.
