

Deed of Arch Lindsey & Gada Lindsey

State of Florida Know all men by these presents that we A. Lindsey and J. M. Lindsey his wife who joins his said husband in the execution of this deed for the purpose of conveying the rights of above in to the lands herein after described for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar to us in hand paid by Gada Lindsey the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Gada Lindsey his and assigns forever the following described real estate situated lying and being in County of Santa Rosa State of Florida to wit: Commencing eight hundred yds from the N.E. corner of the Antonio Molino Grant situated in Township One south of Range 6 West at a point on the Bay of St. Mary de Galvez thence west parallel with the northern line of said Grant 1170 yds to a point - thence south 210 yds thence east parallel with said northern line to the Bay of St. Mary de Galvez thence north along said Bay to the point of Commence containing offy. acre more or less - Together with the improvements thereon and the hereditaments and appurtenants thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining. Do give and to hold the said above described premises unto the said Gada Lindsey his heirs and assigns forever, free from all exemption or bonded rights or claim of third the said grantee if any such right or claim they possess

And I the said grantor for my self and my heirs do covenant with the said grantee his heirs and assigns that the said real estate is free from any lien or incumbrance in law or equity, and that the said grantee shall and will warrant and by these presents forever defend the said premises unto the said grantee his heirs and assigns against the claim of all and every persons or person whomsoever
