J. Stewart Company of the County of Santa Rosa, State of Florida, have granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said S. J. Stewart Company and their heirs and assigns, forever, the following described lands to wit: The North East quarter of the South East quarter and the South East quarter of the South West quarter of section sixteen (16) in Township Three (3) North of Range Twenty five (25) West. Containing seven and 2/3 acres, and lying and being in the County of Santa Rosa in said State of Florida. Do have and to hold the said lands unto the said S. J. Stewart Company and their heirs and assigns, forever.

In testimony whereof, the members of said Board have hereunto subscribed their names and affixed their seals and have caused the seal of the Department of Agriculture of the State of Florida to be hereunto affixed at the Capital in the City of Tallahassee on this the twenty second day of October A.D. eighteen hundred and ninety two
