 hereby acknowledged and confessed have given granted
 bargained and sold, and by these presents do give grant
 bargain & sell unto the said L. P. Meek the following
 personal property known and described as follows. To
 wit: of Horse caps the same now being in my
 possession at my home in the Co. and State aforesaid and
 being all the horse caps belonging to me or in my
 possession at this time, the same being marked as
 follows to wit: One York marked smooth cap in one ear
 and under square under bit in the other - with no brand
 the other York one ear is marked cap under over bit in
 each ear, branded J.H. and the other marked over square under
 bit in one ear and over slope and two under bits in the other
 branded H. To have and to hold the said property to
 the said L. P. Meek his heirs executors administrators
 and assigns to him and their use and behoof forever
 And I the said B. L. Meek Covenant to Warrant and defend
 the title to said property unto the said L. P. Meek his Administrators
 executors and assigns against the lawful claims and
 demands of any and all persons whomsoever.
 Now the foregoing instrument is intended as a
 mortgage and is given to the said L. P. Meek in order
 to secure him in the payment of a certain note given
 Sept 20th 1892 described as follows: Three months after
 date with 10% interest per annum for the sum of one
 hundred dollars (\$100.) Now then if the said note with
 interest is paid at maturity then this obligation to be
 null and void else of full force and virtue. And
 in case of foreclosure said B. L. Meek agrees to pay all
 reasonable cost of foreclosure and reasonable attorney
