To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting
Homestead Certificate No 90357
Application 20457
Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the General Land Office at Gainesville Florida whereby it appears that pursuant to the act of Congress approved 20th May 1862 "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the Public Domain" and the acts supplemental thereto the claim of Joseph Redd has been duly established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the West half of the North East quarter and the East half of the North West quarter or the lot numbered one section thirty in Township two North of Range twenty six West of Tallahassee Meridian in Florida containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the official Plat of the survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General

Now therefore know ye that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Joseph Redd the tract of Land above described. To have and to hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereof unto the said Joseph Redd and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I Benjamin Harrison, President of the United States of America have caused these Letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the Seventeenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety one and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and fiftieth
