 To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting
 Whereas there was law deposited in the General
 Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the
 said Office at Gainesville Florida whereby it appears that
 pursuant to the act of Congress approved 20 May 1862
 Secure Homestead to actual Settlers in the Public Domain
 and the acts Supplemental thereto the claim of Benjamin
 Lee has been established and duly consummated in
 conformity to Law for the East half of the North West
 quarter and the East half of the South West quarter
 of Section thirty six in Township two North of Range
 Twenty Nine West of Tallahassee Meridian in
 Florida containing one hundred and sixty seven
 and nine hundredths of an acre according to the
 official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the
 General Land Office by the Surveyor General
 now known as that there is therefore granted by
 the United States unto the said Benjamin L. Lee
 the tract of Land above described:
 To have and to hold the said tract of Land with
 the appurtenances thereof unto the said Benjamin
 L. Lee and to his heirs and assigns forever
 In testimony whereof Benjamin Harrison President
 of the United States of America have caused these letters to be
 made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office
 to be hereunto affixed
 Given under my hand at the City of Washington
 the third day of July in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and eighty nine
 and of the Independence of the United States
 the one hundred and thirteenth
