Heretofore (H. R. 10112) Do all to whom these presents shall
Application 17955. Com. Granting
Whereas there has been deposited
in the General Land Office Dept. United States a
Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at
Gainesville Florida whereby it appears
that pursuant to the act of Congress approved
May 20 1802 "To Secure Homesteads to
Actual Settlers on the Public Domain" and
the acts supplemental thereto the claim of
Wesley P. Henderson has been established
and duly consummated in conformity
to law for the West half of the North East
quarter and the East half of the North West
quarter of Section Eight in Township one
North of Range twenty nine West of
Tallahassee Meridian in Florida (containing
one hundred and fifty nine acres and ninety
four hundredths of an acre - according to
the official Plat of the Survey of the said land
returned to the General Land Office by the
Surveyor general

Now know ye that there is therefore granted
by the United States unto the said Wesley P.
Henderson the tract of land above described
to have and to hold the said tract of land
with the appurtenances thereof unto the said
Wesley P. Henderson and to his heirs and
assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I Benjamin Harrison
President of the United States of America have
caused these letters to be made Patent, and
the seal of the General Land Office to be
hereunto affixed.
