aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
and confessed, have given granted bargained and  
sold and by these presents do give grant bargain  
and sell unto the said W. M. Smith his heirs and  
assigns the following piece or parcel of land, lying  
and being situated in the County of Santa Rosa, State  
of Florida and described as follows to wit: The South  
West quarter of the South West quarter of Section Twenty  
Seven (27) in Township Three (3) North of Range Twenty Five  
(25) West containing Forty (40) acres more or less  
together with all and singular the rights appurtenances  
and hereditaments thereto belonging or in any way  
appertaining, To have and to hold the said  
premises unto the said W. M. Smith his heirs  
and assigns in fee Simple forever.

And we the said Grantors for ourselves our  
heirs Adminisutors and assigns do hereby  
Covenant to warrant and defend the title to  
the said land unto the said Smith his heirs  
and assigns against the lawful claims  
and demands of any and all persons
