Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Gainesville Florida whereby it appears that pursuant to the act of Congress approved 20<sup>th</sup> May 1862 to secure Homesteads actual Settlers on the Public Domain and the acts supplemental thereto the claim of Johanna M. Nowling has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the South East Quarter of Section thirty two in Township two South of Range twenty eight West of Tallahassee meridian in Florida containing one hundred and sixty acres and twenty eight hundredths of an acre, according to the official Plat of the survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, Now know ye that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Johanna M. Nowling the tract of Land above described to have and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereof unto the said Johanna M. Nowling and to her heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof Benjamin Harrison, President of the United States of America, have caused this Order to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
