Know all men by these presents that in consideration of one hundred (\$100) to me in hand paid by the Receiver, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I do bargain grant sell & convey to said Receiver the one the one third Interest of the Bayou Mulletto Mill site described as follows situated in Section 34 Town one North Range 29 West Beginning at the Bullhead at Bayou Mulletto Bridge thence along side of the said Rail Road in a North East direction four hundred (400) feet to a Stone then North of West to a Stone on the Bayou (175) feet one hundred and seventy five and we the said grantors for our selves and our heirs do covenant with the said grantee his heirs and assigns will warrant and defend the said premises unto the said grantee his heirs and assigns against the claims of all persons what so ever
