State of Florida } Know all men by these presents, that for
County of Escambia } and in Consideration of the sum of six
hundred and fifty-two ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ (652⁰⁰/₁₀₀) dollars
paid and secured to be paid by John P. Cory and William
Ollinger Copartners under firm name of Cory & Ollinger
to the Pensacola & Atlantic Railroad Company, a corporation
chartered by the State of Florida, the receipt whereof is
truly acknowledged, the said Pensacola & Atlantic
Railroad Company, has granted bargained and
sold and by these presents does grant bargain
sell and convey unto said John P. Cory and William
Ollinger all the following tracts or parcels of land, situate
in the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida and described
as follows to wit: the East half, the North West
quarter of the North West quarter and the South West
quarter of Section Nine (9) in Township two (2)
North of Range twenty-four (24) West, containing
five hundred twenty-two ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ acres more or less
to have and to hold unto the said John P. Cory
and William Ollinger their heirs executors, and
assigns forever. Now therefore, in consideration
of the premises, the said Pensacola & Atlantic
Railroad Company hereby warrants and defends
title in and to the aforegranted premises to the
said John P. Cory and William Ollinger in fee
simple forever. And in pursuance of the third
section in the Mortgage, executed by the said Pensacola
& Atlantic Railroad Company to Edmund Randolph
and John L. Cadwalader as Trustees, dated 1st April 1888
duly acknowledged and recorded the said Randolph
and Cadwalader hereby convey all their interest as said
Trustees in said land, to the said John P. Cory and William
Ollinger, this being as to them a quit claim as trustees
and without warranty of title by them,
In testimony whereof the said Pensacola & Atlantic Railroad
Company has send and by authority of a resolution
of its Board of Directors signed the instrument by
its President and attested the same by causing the
seal of the Company to be affixed by its Secretary,
and the said Edmund Randolph and John L. Cadwalader
