 of the Land Office at Gainesville Florida, whereby it
 appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved
 20th May 1862 Do same Homestead to actual settler on
 the Public Domain and the acts supplemental thereto
 the claim of James S. Spear has been established and
 duly consummated, in conformity to law for the
 North East quarter of Section fourteen in Township
 one north of Range twenty nine west of Tallahassee
 meridian in Florida, containing one hundred and sixty
 acres and thirteen hundredths of an acre according
 to the official Plot of J. C. Smokey of the said Land returned
 to the general Land Office by the Surveyor general
 Now know ye that there is therefore granted by the
 United States unto the said James S. Spear the
 tract of Land above described; Do have and to hold
 the said tract of Land with the appurtenances
 thereof unto the said James S. Spear and to his
 heirs and assigns forever.
