is hereby acknowledged, do bargain sell and  
Convey and grant unto the Trustees of the  
Methodist Episcopal Church South and their  
successors in office, their heirs Executors  
Administrators and assigns forever, the  
following described property, to-wit: One (1)  
acre of land or which the Methodist Episcopal  
Church South have erected a Church building, being in  
the South East Corner of the North half of Lot Six (6)  
in Section Twenty-eight (28) Township five (5) Range  
30 in Sanford County Fla.

Together with all and singular the tenements,  
hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging  
or in anywise appertaining, free from all  
exception and right of homestead.

And we the Covenant that we are well seized of the  
property and have a good right to convey the  
same, that it is free of incumbrances and  
that our heirs Executors and Administrators  
the said grantee their heirs Executors Administra-  
tors and assigns in the quiet and peaceable possession  
and enjoyment thereof against all persons  
lawfully claiming the same. Shall and will  
forever warrant and defend.
