Harrington shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid said note together with the interest due thereon when the same becomes due, then this instrument to be null and void, else to remain in full force and virtue. It is also understood and agreed that in the event of a foreclosure of this instrument, the said Ollinger is to be allowed all costs and reasonable attorneys fee, the same to be included in and covered by this mortgage.
