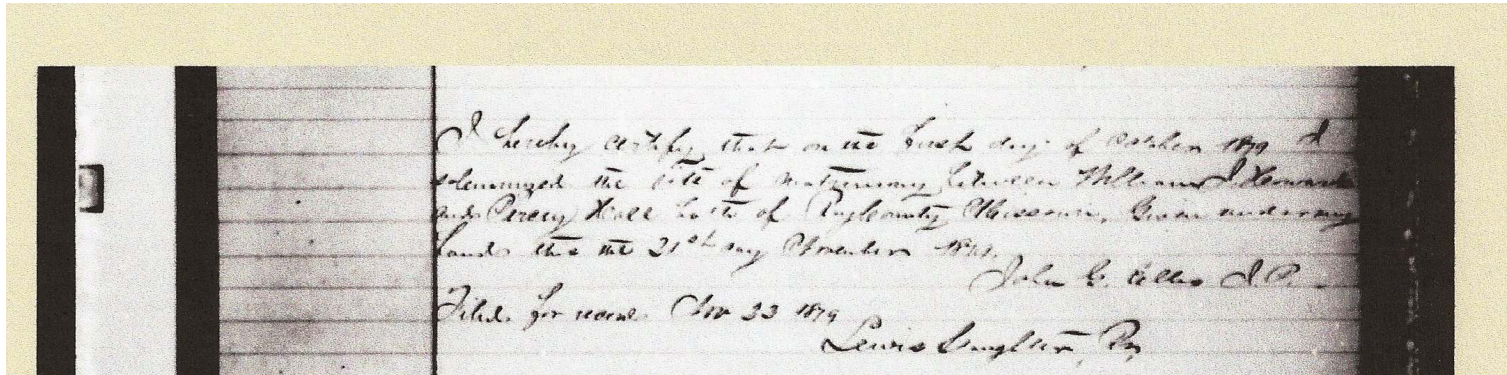


This is the marriage record for Percy's third marriage. She married William J. Howard on November 21st, 1879. Many Ray County marriage records are online at Ancestry.com, but as you can see they're extremely difficult to read. I did my best to transcribe it. Note the spelling of Percy's name – this is probably the most misspelled name we come across.
