**G. W. M'CURDY.**

**Death of a Well Known Dunns-  
table Township Farmer.**

The venerable G. W. McCurdy, who resided along the river road between this city and Charlton, died Friday morning after a short illness with pneumonia. He was about 74 years old. He was the father of County Commissioner McCurdy and of Cyrus McCurdy, the well-known tobacco man. Deceased is also survived by other children. Mr. McCurdy was a farmer greatly esteemed by his acquaintances.

Services over the remains of G. W. McCurdy were conducted at 1 30 o'clock Monday afternoon at the residence, instead of in Ziegler's church, as originally intended. Mrs. McCurdy, the widow, and the following named children survive: J. A., and Mrs. Jennie Waters, of Pine Creek township; G. T., of Williamsport; Mrs. Annie Dort, of Tioga county, and C. B., A. D. and Agnes at home.
