- 3,180 of the names came from the Hatboro Cemetery Records and 1,637 came from gravestone inscriptions for a total of 4,817 interments.
- Privacy Considerations:
 - If a death date is missing on an inscription, the name is NOT included in the Master Index.
 - Addresses for LotOwner1, LotOwner2 and Next of Kin are not printed for any interments that died after 1931.
- Some interments marked "No Cemetery Card" could represent a burial that happened after this project was started in the spring of 1995. If the burial happened after 1995, please visit the caretakers of the Hatboro Cemetery to obtain any additional lot information.
- Any discrepancies in lot #'s.
 - ◆ Lot #'s represented in the "Cemetery Records" came from the Hatboro Cemetery Records.
 - ◆ Lot #'s represented in the "Inscription Section" were estimated from plot plans.
- WARNING: Interment names listed in the Master Index came directly from the Hatboro Cemetery Records and they could be spelled incorrectly. The names were dictated to the cemetery caretaker from funeral homes and family members, etc. "Trust the spelling of the names as much as you would trust the spelling of names received from the newspapers"
