Port Carbon St Stephen's R.C. Church Tombstone Inscriptions

Recorded and Compiled from February to May 1990.

Highlights of this Cemetary:

This is the largest cemetary in Port Carbon with over 1400 burials.

The older sections of this cemetary reveal information relating to the early Irish Immigrants and from where in Ireland they came.

Over 35 Civil War Veterans buried in this cemetary.

A large number of the tombstones in this cemetary (primarily in Sections 1 & 2) are old and badly eroded. I would encourage anyone searching for additional information to visit the cemetary personally. Also, several errors may exist in this listing due to inacurate transcription from these stones. I have attempted to indicate (with a question mark) those stones which are badly eroded and should be revisited.

St. Stephens Roman Catholic Church is located at the corner of Valley and North Streets in Port Carbon.
