B. P. Adems, Deceased Confederate Pensioner. File No. 30287 Henderson Co.

The records of this office show one B. P. Adams, not shown as Bolin Pinkney Adams, filed application for Confederate Pension in Texas in January, 1913. At that time he stated he was 68 years old-born in McNairy County, Temmessee. He had resided in Texas for 63 years.

Mr. Adams stated he served about eight months in McHarn's Company, Jamison's Regiment of Texas Infantry, Confederate States Army as a private. He was discharged at Tyler, Texas in May or June of 1865.

The application of B. P. Adams was approved on the affidavits of J. K. P. Parmer and H. W. Richardson who stated they both joined the same company at Athens, Texas with B. P. Adams and they served with him in the same organization.

B. P. Adams death occurred September 10, 1921 in the home of his son-in-law, J. M. Royall in Athens, Texas. He was buried in the Fincastle Cometery in Henderson County, Texas.

No further information of the service of Mr. Adoms is given.
