any one hold in trust for my benefit or use, nor does my wife own, nor does any one hold in trust for my wife,
estate or property, either real, personal or mixed, either in fee or for life, of the assessed value of over one thousand
dollars, exclusive of a home of the value of not more than \$1000.00; nor do I receive any aid or pension from any
other State, or from the United States, or from any other source, and that I am not an inmate of the Confederate
