Cavalry of Tennessee, no pak no soldier of the Confederacy ever wore the colors of more honorably the South than said Cofer did.


have All of his comrades that were in his Co. pass over, except one P. B. Nance whose testimony has heretofore been taken, is the only one that I have any remeberance of being alive.

Mr. Cofer has always born a good reputation for truith and veracity from his younger days through life.

He left this part of Tennessee some 17 or 18 years ago and when heard from by his friends back here he was located in Henderson County, State of Texas. Many years ago I have heard the said Cofer and his comreds relate many of the incidents of their war life.

I have never known but one William Cofer and he is the one mentioned above and he was honorably entitled to be relieved from war duty on the account of his right hand having been mangled when he was a boy, having only index finger & thumb left; but he preferred to serve his country in this condition rather than to bushwhack.
