No later record of this soldier has been found.

Harris in the Confederacy is having served in the same company with him, and we know of no other soldier of the mame of D. B. Harris serving in said company, and we are positively certain that D. B. Harris is the same person serving as herein testified, and we further know that D. B. Harris never deserted the Comfederacy.
