



The records show that E. W. Harrison was a private in Company A, 45th Alabama Infantry C. S. A. He enlisted in 1861 at the beginning of the war and was discharged April 24, 1865.

The application for pension of E. W. Harrison was approved on original documents filed with the application and issued to Mr. Harrison by his commanding officers.
