My dear Mr. Sanders:

I have your letter of March 12, with which you inclosed one, herewith returned, from Mrs. R. D. Melton, Box 62, Malakoff, Texas, who requests the Confederate military record of Dr. R. D. Melton, said to have served as a surgeon.

The records show that one R. D. Melton, M.D., signed a receipt roll for \$80.00, dated at Monroe, Louisiana, July 21, 1863, for one month service rendered at Hospital #2, from June 20 to July 20, 1863. This voucher was approved by J. C. Cummings, Post Surgeon, and was paid by Captain William Oliver, Quartermaster, C.S.A. No other record of him has been found, nor does that name appear on the rolls on file of any Confederate States Army organization.

The collection of Confederate records in this Department is incomplete, and the failure to find the complete record of a person thereon is by no means conclusive proof that such person did not serve during some period not covered by the records.
